



Glenn A. Johnson, Mayor, Term: 2004-2007; 2008-2011; 2012-2015

In November 2011, Glenn became the first mayor in the history of Pullman to be elected to three, four-year

He is a past president of the Association of Washington Cities (AWC), a group that represents 281 cities

Glenn earned the Advanced Certificate of Municipal Leadership from AWC in September 2008 and rece

Before becoming mayor, Glenn was elected to the Pullman Memorial Hospital Board of Commissioners

He is on the board of directors of the Pullman Chamber of Commerce and was the 1999-2000 chamber

Glenn first became active in helping the city of Pullman when he was asked to co-chair a committee to g
