1	3	333'	-16'	B	N	Hilltop at dogleg hides target from tee.
2	3	167'	+9'	B	N	Pathway near target is hidden from tee. Post a lookout if you can.
3	3	292'	+3'	B	Y	
4	3	343'	+2'	B	N	
5	3	329'	+35'	P	Y	Throw hard. Elevation rise makes this hole longer than it looks.
6	3	170'	-13'	P	Y	A breeze on #6 can blow your birdie drive to double-bogeyville.
7	3	205'	-20'	P	Y	Target barely visible. Overshoot #7 and watch it roll into the woods.
8	3	307'	+17'	P	Y	
9	3	257'	-26'	B	N	Target #3 visible from tee. Step forward around tree to sight #9.
10	3	255'	+6'	B	Y	Picnickers often around #10. Lost disc? Overshoots can roll into pond.

12	3	159'	-33'	B	Y	Discs can roll into pond when #12 is overshoot.

14	3	336'	+11'	B	Y	A disc in the summer thicket is a sticky situation.

16	3	343'	+54'	B	Y	Throw hard. #16's elevation rise makes it more like 400'.

18	3	323'	-8'	P	Y	Be aware of people and cars in parking lot behind target.

General Cautions and Notes:

The Sunnyside Park disc golf course is here because we have shown that disc golf can co-exist with other activities. PLEASE exercise the utmost caution when throwing a disc near people or property.

Foot traffic on park pathways can often be hidden from view. Make sure pathways are clear before you throw.

Be considerate when retrieving an errant disc from agricultural crops or public gardens. Do no damage.

Tees are marked with two wire stemmed blue plastic flags. However, these flags disappear from time to time. Look for worn spots on turf when flags are missing.

A hole is made on a post target by striking the brown area of the post with the disc.

A walking tour of the entire course (Tee 1 to Target 18) is about 1.3 miles.
