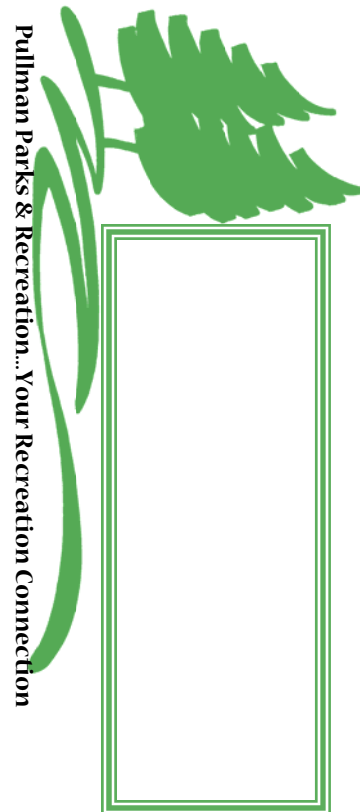

***An important part of using the xeriscape concept is to group plants with similar water needs together in beds. Allowing them to be watered as needed reducing water waste.***
