



Riverview and South Street

(8.66 acres) Situated along the South Fork of the Palouse River are the three softball fields (Thatuna, Bowman, and Wiley) that constitute the Pullman City Playfields. This is the main athletic facility for Pullman's summer sports. A jogging track, exercise stations, volleyball standards, batting cage, picnic tables, drinking fountains and restrooms are also part of this athletic complex. Henry Cole dedicated the land for the City Playfield to the city in 1941. Wiley Field was lighted in 1979 and Bowman Field in 1985.

The site of Adult Softball from May-Sept. Pullman Parks & Recreation has softball leagues for men, women, coed, and church. Call 338-3227 for more information.
