1. Judy moved and Rob seconded approving minutes from the July 20, 2011 Regular meeting.
2. Rob moved and Judy seconded approving August salary warrants. All voted and the warrants were accepted as presented.
3. Announcements and Reports
  - a. Manager's report accepted as presented.
  - b. Friends of Neill Public Library
    - i. The Friends are sponsored a dessert reception on Wednesday, July 27 with children's musician Victor Johnson.
    - ii. Lentil Festival – the Friends will have a booth where they will be raffling 3 baskets of books for adults, teens, and children, as a fundraiser.
