### **Injury Investigation**

**PULLMAN** – On Saturday, September 10 at 12:01 am, Pullman Police were called to the 500 block of NE Kamiaken St. on a report of an injured subject. Officers found 20-year-old Chad Heffelfinger semi-conscious with head injuries lying at the base of an approximate twenty-four foot retaining wall. Heffelfinger was transported by the Pullman Fire Department to Pullman Regional Hospital and later flown to Sacred Heart Medical Center in Spokane with serious injuries.

Heffelfinger is a Washington State University student living in Pullman and originally from Vancouver, Washington. An investigation by the Pullman Police Department is in progress. Preliminary investigation indicates the subject fell off the retaining wall.
